



Using Stitt Library’s print resources long distance

Although you have access to a large collection of e-books and full text online journal articles, we realize that not everything you need will always be available online. If you are an Austin Seminary student who lives outside of Austin, there are ways to borrow books from Stitt Library and get access to articles that aren’t available electronically.

Find and borrow a book at Stitt Library

Use the online catalog or Print Books Only menu in Sophi Search to search for a book by title, author, or keyword. Once you have found a book that you are interested in, verify that it is available in the APTS stacks. Note that we can only send you books from our library, not from our library catalog partner, the Seminary of the Southwest (SSW):
