Annual Copyright License

- What is it?
 - A product of the Copyright Clearance Center (CCC)
 - "...a single, comprehensive license that allows faculty, librarians, researchers and staff to reuse text-based copyrighted content for educational purposes, while respecting the intellectual property of others."

Annual Copyright License

- What does it really mean?
 - If a resource is covered by the Annual Copyright License, you can make it available in any format to your students.
 - You can share multiple chapters from a book or multiple articles from a journal.
 - You can share the resources for multiple semesters.



Annual Copyright License

- Currently includes over 1.6 million titles.
- Twenty new publishers are added each month.
- Participating publishers include:
 - Augsburg Fortress
 - Brill Academic Publications
 - Continuum Publishing Company
 - Oxford University Press
 - Westminster / John Knox Press

The Rules

- You can use multiple chapters from a book, but you still can't reproduce the entire thing.
- Some publishers may put additional restrictions on use.
- Scan should always be made from an original owned by the Seminary or the instructor.
- If you are unsure if a work is covered or if there is a publisher that you would like to see included on the list, let Kristy know.

Case Studies

- Can I make copies of two chapters from a covered work and pass them out to my class?

Yes – multiple chapters are fine under this license

Case Studies

- There is a resource I use every semester that I want to put on my course portal, and it is covered under the license. Can I use it?

Yes – multiple semesters are allowed if a resource is covered by the license.
